



May's Amazing Maze Scatter

Saturday 5 May 2018

Supplementary Regulations

1. Farnborough District Motor Club (FDMC) will promote a Clubsport Navigational Scatter on Saturday 5 May 2018.
2. The meeting will be held under the General Regulations of the MSA (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of FIA), these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions the organising Club may issue for this event.
3. MSA Permit number 106718 has been issued for this event.
4. The event is open to all members of FDMC, but these Regulations are also an open invitation to any other MSA recognised Clubs. Details of other Clubs that accept this invitation will be confirmed in the Finals.
5. The start venue will be a layby on the A287 at 186/759 512. Mid-point marshal details appear in the annexe to these Regulations and the finish will be at Mill Lane Services, also on the A287 at 186/789 503.
6. Signing-on will be from 19:15. Route information will be handed out to Beginners and Novices at 19:45 and to Semis and Experts at 20:00.
7. Each crew will comprise driver and navigator only, both of whom must sign the official signing-on sheet at the start and produce their Club membership cards.
8. Recommended equipment: OS Landranger Map Sheet 186, (any recent edition); collapsible map-board; map-reading light; torch; pencils & eraser and romer. **Completion of the event will be possible with no special equipment other than a good torch.**
9. Classes will be as defined in the annexe to these Regulations.

12. The entry list opens on publication of these regulations and closes at midnight on Thursday 3 May 2018. Entries should be made on the Entry Form attached, which may be scanned and emailed to the Secretary or posted to arrive no later than the closing date. Payment will be by presentation of a cheque for £5 (payable to Farnborough District Motor Club) or cash at sign-on.
13. There will be no timing on the event other than limited times for visiting a mid-point marshal as detailed in the annexe to these Regulations.
14. The organisers reserve the right to abandon, cancel, postpone or delete all or part of the event due to unforeseen circumstances.
15. You must ensure that you and your vehicle are covered by insurance as required by the Road Traffic Act. See paragraph 21 for insurance which can be arranged on your behalf. Note that most insurance policies exclude use in this type of event. If you wish to use your own private Motor Insurance, you will be required to declare that your policy includes appropriate cover on the entry form.



16. All search points will be roadside furniture or fittings identified by 10 figure OS references and will be scored as detailed in the annexe to these Regulations.
17. A maximum of 75% of Search Points will count towards the final score. If more than 75% are recorded on scorecards excess points will be deleted and will not count.
18. The winners will be the crew with the highest score calculated as detailed in the annexe to these Regulations. A tie should not be possible, but should a tie occur the organiser(s) will define a tie-break method on declaring the results.
19. Provisional Results will be announced as soon as possible at the finish, and these will be emailed or posted to entrants within 7 days of the event. Protests must be in accordance with MSA GRs C 5.1 to 5.7.
20. Awards will be presented to the winning Navigator and Driver.
21. Competitors must have insurance in place which provides Third Party Liability cover that complies with the Road Traffic Act. This can be an extension of the existing motor policy for the car or purchased via the event organisers. If a competitor uses an extension to an existing policy, they will be required to sign a declaration that the cover complies with the requirements of the Road Traffic Act. Any responsibility for a fraudulent or misleading declaration about existing cover lies with the competitor. If a competitor wishes to purchase cover via the organisers, then they can do so at sign-on at a cost of £20 in addition to the entry fee providing they comply with the following;
 - Age 19 or over
 - Has held a full licence for a minimum of 6 months
 - Has no more than 6 points on their licence
 - Has had no more than 1 fault claim in the last 3 years

Anyone aged less than 19 years old will also be accepted at the same price should their co-driver be a more senior member of their family or over 25. Any competitor, who falls outside these parameters, may be offered cover at the standard price (or a higher price) depending on circumstances. These competitors must ask the event organisers to obtain agreement from the underwriter prior to the event. The Event Organiser's RTA scheme is provided by REIS and underwritten by Chaucer Insurance

Please complete and return the entry form and make sure that you read the annexe to these Regulations so that you know how the classes will work and what the event format will be.
