FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

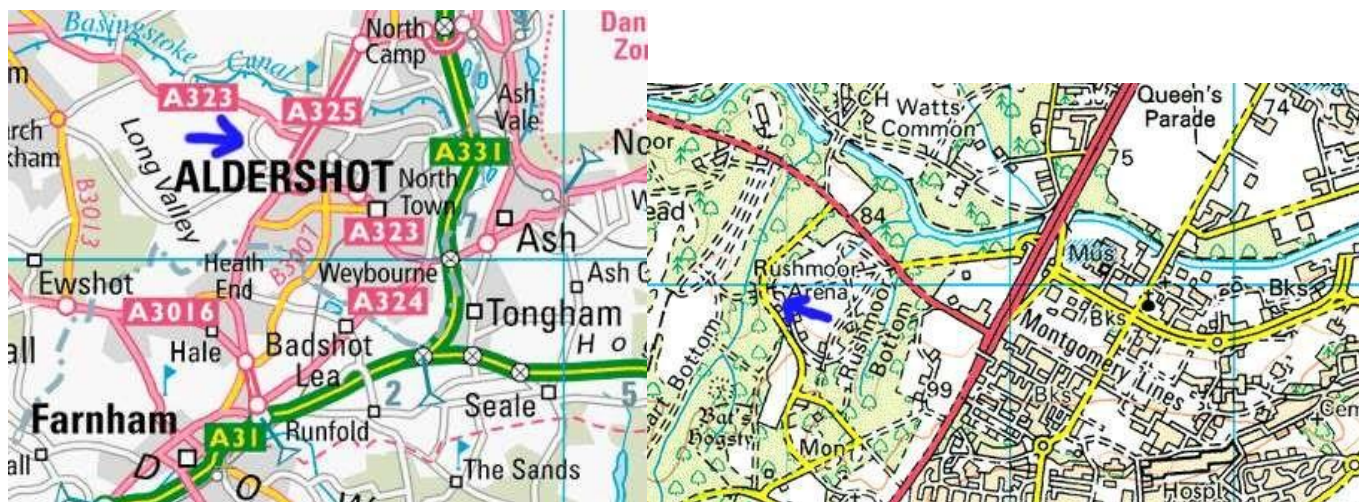
(Having the same force as the GCR's of Motorsport UK and the SSR's issued for this event)

Many thanks for your entry. Please find below the official Final Instructions for the event.

1. Please report first to the Scrutineering Area between 07-15 and 08-30 hours where you will be issued with your Process Card. Do not forget that Noise Test and Scrutineering will take place before signing on. In the event of any anticipated lateness, you should telephone Michael Weeks the Entries Secretary on 07881 625446 before 21-30 on Saturday 18th May, or after 07-00 on Sunday 19th May. Any Competitor arriving after 09-00 on the morning of the event without informing the Entries Secretary may be excluded from the event.
2. The programme for the event is as per Para 6

Scrutineering starts:	07-15

Drivers Briefing:	08-45
Practice Runs start:	09-00
Timed Runs start:	13-00 (Approx)
3. Once you have successfully completed Scrutineering proceed to the Event HQ with your process card and documentation to sign on. You WILL need to present your process card at the start line of your first practice run. We will not be issuing you with time cards due to computerised timing. Printed results will be displayed on the Event HQ throughout the day.
4. Para.9. A provisional entry list, as at closing date, is attached. In the event of some classes having insufficient entries, the Organisers reserve the right to amalgamate them, where necessary, prior to commencement of the event.
5. Para. 14. Motorsport UK Steward – Mr. Tony Watts. Chief Medical Officer – Mr. Murray Stevens
6. Para. 18. Please do not forget that there will be NO convoy runs due to the constraints of the course. If you wish to walk or cycle the course please make sure that you do so after Scrutineering but before the Drivers Briefing at 08-45.
7. Para. 19. You are reminded to provide your own competition numbers (compliant with GR J.4.1 & J.4.1.5) and to ensure that all other numbers have been removed from your competition car. Double driven cars should ensure that the correct number is displayed.
8. Para. 28. Trailers/Transporters. You are reminded that you must unload your competition car, tools, wheels etc from your trailer on arriving at the paddock and then park the trailer/transporter in the designated area. You will be guided to this area by Officials/Marshals. There will be no exceptions to this regulation and failure to comply will result in a report to the Clerk of the Course.

9. If you are in a road going class please remember to bring paper proof of your Insurance, MOT and Tax. MOT and Tax can be proved and printed from the Government website:

10. A Timing Strut must be fitted to the competing car as per GR S.10.9
11. There will be a full, good quality, catering service on site and we would ask you to support this during the day.
12. Please Note: Due to new gates that have been installed at either end of Rushmoor Road, you will only be able to access the venue from the A323 Fleet Road end of Rushmoor Road.
