SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. Farnborough District Motor Club Limited will organise a Clubman permit Autotest on Sunday 10th December 2023, at Rushmoor Arena, Aldershot, near to GU11 2HL. What3words: **flames.daily.danger**.
2. The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of Motorsport UK Ltd, (incorporating the provisions of the International Code of the FISA), these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event.
3. Motorsport UK Permit has been applied for and granted Permit Number TBA.
4. The event is open to all fully elected and paid-up members of the organising club, who must produce a valid club membership card at signing on. Minimum age is defined by Motorsport UK as 16 on the day of the event.
5. The programme of the event is as follows:
 - Signing-On from 10:30 hours.
 - Any competitor not signed on by 10:45 hours may be excluded.
 - Drivers and marshals briefing 10:50 hours.
 - First competitor starts at 11:00 hours.
6. All competitors will use vehicles supplied by the organisers. These vehicles will be allocated to a test and each competitor will use the same vehicle on that test.
7. Awards will be presented as follows:
 - First overall,
 - Second overall,
 - Fastest on last test,
 - Last overall.

No competitor may win more than one award.
8. The Entry List opens on publication of these regulations and closes at noon on the day before the event. The Entry Fee is £35.00. All entries must be made on-line or on the official entry form.
9. Enter online on the FDMC website: www.fdmc.org.uk/box23
10. Payment is best made on the same webpage using Paypal (it accepts guest payment with various credit or debit cards). Entries should be acknowledged by email within 5 days.
11. The maximum entry for the meeting is 35, the minimum is 15. Should the minimum entry not be reached the organisers have the right to cancel the event. Entry fees may be refunded at the organisers' discretion. Priority

entry will be given to those with most Lloyd Roberts Trophy marshal points recorded when the maximum entry is reached.

12. Entries will be seeded on a lottery basis, (Time cards 1-35). A card will be drawn out of a box on receipt of the entry slip and that will be the competitor's competition number for the day.
13. Officials of the meeting are: Clerk of the Course: Ian Morris, Club Steward: Paul Prescott, Secretary of the Meeting: Steve Castle, Safe guarding officer: Jess Castle. Entries secretary Simon Taylor 07966 826 706 or email simontaylor@fdmc.org.uk.
14. It is the intention of the organisers that each competitor will have two attempts at each test, reliability of vehicles permitting, with the best only to count for the results. However, because of the nature of the event the possibility of mechanical problems cannot be over looked. **Please respect the vehicles.** The organisers therefore reserve the right to take whatever action they deem necessary to ensure that this unique event proceeds in a fair and timely manner.
15. Timing will be by hand held stopwatches. There will be a verbal starting signal by the marshal of "3,2,1, Go". The order of attempting tests will be as directed by the Clerk of the Course. Markers may be less than 1 metre in height (M4.2). Practising will **NOT BE ALLOWED**.
16. Competitors will be identified by numbers, on the Time-cards supplied by the organisers.
17. Provisional results will be published following the end of the event.
18. Any protest must be lodged in accordance with General Regulation C 5.1.1- 5.1.2.
19. All other Motorsport UK General Regulations apply as written.
